 - Please strictly comply with the page limits specified by the Social Simulation Conference. Usually, extended abstracts are 4-6 pages and full papers are 12-14 pages including references
 - Your model can be at any stage of development, but remember the more clearer your model description and questions are, the more likely it is that ESSA@work can help
